

**TOURNAMENT INFORMATION  
WILL CALL**

For your convenience, tickets may be picked up or left at the Will Call Trailer, located at I-25 and Happy Canyon Road (Exit 187) on the northwest corner. Hours of Operation:

- Sunday, 8/6; 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
- Monday – Tuesday, 8/7-8/8; 6:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, 8/9; 5:30 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
- Thursday – Friday, 8/10-8/11; 6:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, 8/12; 6:00 a.m. – one hour after play ends
- Sunday, 8/13; 7:00 a.m. – one hour after play ends (approximately 5 p.m.)

**Restricted Items:**

- Carry items – such as backpacks, packages, duffels and oversized camera cases – that are larger than 6" x 6" are NOT PERMITTED. These items will be confiscated, so please leave them in your car.
- Cellular telephones, pagers, radios, portable televisions, coolers or folding chairs that are stored in carrying cases are NOT PERMITTED on the grounds at any time. These items will be confiscated.
- Cameras and video equipment are permitted on the grounds Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday only. After Wednesday, cameras will be confiscated.

**MONDAY, August 7**

Youth Day • A special day devoted just to kids!

The INTERNATIONAL Pro-Junior Challenge

8:00 a.m. PGA TOUR Pros play a five-hole loop with Junior Golfers (Holes #10,11,16,17,18)

11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Free lunch for kids. Redeem coupons at any concession stand

12:30 p.m. – 1:30 p.m. Exhibition by a PGA TOUR Pro, Trick Shot Exhibition, and Golf Exhibition featuring Disabled Golfers

PGA TOUR Pro-Am Tournament • Shotgun start at 11:00 a.m. Each pairing consists of one PGA TOUR Pro + four amateurs.

Practice Rounds for the Pros • Immediately following the Pro-Am at approximately 3:30 p.m.

**TUESDAY, August 8**

Practice rounds for the Pros • All day. Random pairings.

**WEDNESDAY, August 9**

Two PGA TOUR Pro-Am Tournaments • Shotgun starts at 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

Each pairing consists of one PGA TOUR Pro + three amateurs.

**THURSDAY, August 10**

Round 1 of The INTERNATIONAL • 144 Players begin play using the Modified Stableford Scoring System.

Tee times begin at approximately 7:00 a.m. at the 1st and 10th tees.

**FRIDAY, August 11**

Round 2 of The INTERNATIONAL • 144 players begin play with the top 70 (plus ties) advancing. Tee times begin at approximately 7:00 a.m. at the 1st and 10th tees.

**SATURDAY, August 12**

Round 3 of The INTERNATIONAL • At least 70 players begin, carrying points from rounds 1 & 2. Top 36 (plus ties) advance to Sunday's final round. Tee times scheduled to begin at approximately 7:45 a.m. at the 1st and 10th tees.

**SUNDAY, August 13**

Final Round of The INTERNATIONAL • At least 36 players begin play, carrying points from rounds 1, 2 & 3. Player with the most points at the end of play is the winner of The INTERNATIONAL. If necessary, a playoff will determine the winner. Playoff holes are #9 and #18, with a repeat rotation as long as necessary. Tee times scheduled to begin at approximately 9:00 a.m. from the 1st tee.



## PARKING AND SHUTTLE INFORMATION

The General Parking Lot is reserved for Daily Ticket holders, Patron Ticket holders and Volunteers. No parking pass is required.

To get to the General Parking Lot from I-25, exit at Meadows/Founders (Exit 184) and follow the signs. The lot is located 3/4 mile north of Happy Canyon Road on Santa Fe Drive (SH85).

To get to the golf course from the parking lots, use either the Front Nine Shuttle or the Back Nine Shuttle.

Note: Security personnel will check for tickets and prohibited items before allowing access to the Shuttle.

### The Front Nine Shuttle

The Front Nine Shuttle runs continually between the General Parking Lot and three shuttle stop locations on the Front Nine Holes of Castle Pines Golf Club. The shuttle stop areas are at hole #3 tee, hole #5 and hole #7.

### The Back Nine Shuttle

The Back Nine Shuttle runs continually between the General Parking Lot and the shuttle stop on Happy Canyon Road at the 16th Green. From there, you will have easy access to hole #s 11, 14, 16 and 17. Hole #9, hole #18 and the Clubhouse are a short walking distance from the shuttle stop.

### Departing the Tournament

From the Clubhouse, you have a number of options to return to the General Parking Lot:

- Follow the 1st and 2nd holes to the 2nd green and use the Front Nine Shuttle
- Follow the 9th and 8th holes to the 7th green and use the Front Nine Shuttle
- Follow the 18th and 17th holes to Happy Canyon Road and use the Back Nine Shuttle
- Follow the 10th hole and crossover to the 17th hole. Follow the 17th hole to Happy Canyon Road and use the Back Nine Shuttle.

Shuttle signs mark the location of each pick-up.

## ATM

ATM machines are located in the outdoor Golf Shops near the Back Nine Shuttle drop-off and #18 green and in Founders Park (between #9 and #18 fairways).

## Bleacher Setting

Covered: Driving Range, #1 tee, #7 green, #10 tee, #10 green, and #11 green. Uncovered: #14 green, and #18 green.

## Cancellation of Play (Ticket Policy)

If play is cancelled prior to 1:00 p.m. for any reason whatsoever, all General Admission tickets for the day that play was cancelled will be honored as General Admission Tickets on any remaining day of the Tournament.

**No refunds or exchanges.**

## First Aid

There are three first aid stations on the course: #7 green, #16 green and at #17 green.

## Food And Beverage

Concession stands are conveniently placed at nine locations throughout the golf course. (Refer to course map.) Each location features an assortment of cold sandwiches, hot dogs, snacks and assorted beverages. All patrons of The INTERNATIONAL may enjoy an upgraded menu and comfort stations in Founders Park (between #9 and #18 fairways) and Willows Park (between #15 and #16). **These two areas are open to the public.** Cash is the only form of payment accepted at all locations.

## Golf Shop Merchandise

Golf Shop merchandise may be purchased at the Clubhouse Golf Shop (OPEN to the PUBLIC), merchandise tents located near the Back Nine Shuttle drop-off, near #18 green and at souvenir huts located throughout the golf course.

## Hotels

The INTERNATIONAL has blocked several rooms at various hotels located within 20 minutes from Castle Pines Golf Club. For information on special Tournament rates, please call 303-660-8000 and ask to be connected with Hotel Reservations.

## Lost And Found

There are two lost and found stations on course located at the Information Booths at the Back Nine Shuttle drop-off near #16 green and behind #18 green. Lost items may be picked up at either location prior to 4:00 p.m. on the day they are lost. After 4:00 p.m., all items not picked up will be taken to the Will Call Trailer, located at I-25 and Happy Canyon Road. Call the Tournament office (303-660-8000) for further assistance.

## Rain Shelters

For your convenience, rain shelters have been erected at the following locations:

- #4 green (concession tent)
- #7 green (concession tent)
- #10 green (concession tent)
- #11 green (concession tent)
- Tunnel from #12 tee to #13 green
- Willows Park between #15 and #16 (concession tent)
- Founders Park between #9 and #18 fairways (concession tent)
- Covered walkway at Clubhouse behind #18 green

In case of inclement weather, remember to avoid open areas, isolated trees, wire fences, golf carts or hilltops/high places. In case of flash floods, avoid tunnels.

## Purchasing Tickets On-Site

Tickets for the day of the event can be purchased at the General Parking Lot and the Will Call Trailer. To purchase tickets for subsequent days while on-site, visit either of the Outdoor Golf Shops – near the Back Nine shuttle drop-off or near #18 green.

## Disabled Accommodations

Once in the General Parking Lot, parking staff will direct any vehicle displaying proper Disabled Parking identification to the reserved parking area. A wheelchair accessible shuttle will be available to transport disabled persons and their guests to one of the Disabled Assistance Areas.

The disabled restroom facilities are located near both of the Disabled Assistance Areas, or are a short distance from the reserved seating areas, located at the 9th, 14th, 16th and 18th green.
